

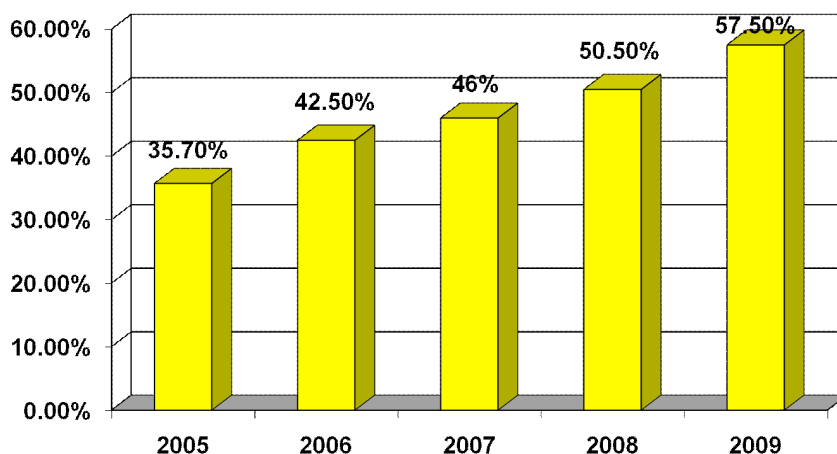
SMUSD Accomplishments from July 2005 to January 2010:

- Since 2005, we have nearly tripled the number of students applying to CSUSM.
- The number of PACE students attending CSUSM has increased by over 3½ times in 4 years.
- The number of students meeting A-G requirements has increased 22% since 2005.
- SMUSD has shown the greatest increase in the number of students applying and enrolling at CSUSM in comparison to other districts in the region (both San Diego and Riverside Counties) over the last 4 years.
