Continuing PACE Promise Scholar Agreement 2012

The CSUSM/PACE Promise Scholars Program provides support and direction to enhance academic success, student involvement, and graduation from CSUSM. To ensure your continued success as a PACE Promise Scholar, you need to work cooperatively with CSUSM advisors to maintain your personalized education plan and continue to commitment to the responsibilities outlined below:

1. PACE Promise agree to maintain full time status at 24 units each academic year (may include summer), at least a 2.0 cumulative GPA and to maintain continuous enrollment at CSUSM.
2. PACE Promise Scholars are required to meet with their advisors every year. These appointments are to update student progress toward the degree and to notify the PACE Promise Coordinator if difficulties are encountered.
3. PACE Promise Scholars should inform the SMUSD if they are participating in other support service programs (e.g., EOP, Faculty- Student Mentoring Programs, Community Service Programs, etc).
4. PACE Promise Scholars must represent the CSUSM/ PACE Promise Program at SMUSD, CSUSM and community events (Ex. 7th grade field trips) throughout their four years at CSUSM.
5. The PACE Promise Scholarships will be awarded to eligible students as long as they are in good standing as a PACE Promise Scholar for a maximum of up to four years. Students who do not participate in mandatory PACE Promise activities and programs, and/or students who leave the program are not eligible for the scholarships.

Failure to comply with these conditions may result in the termination of your PACE Promise Scholar status, services, and/or scholarship.
